1/2 cup chickpeas	2 avocados, cubed	1/2 cup cherry tomatoes, halved
1/2 cup olive oil	2 avocados, cubed	1/2 cup olive oil
1/2 tsp salt	1/2 cup chickpeas	1/2 cup olive oil
1/2 cup spinach, fresh	1/2 cup chickpeas, chopped	1/2 cup olive oil

1. Heat 1 cup of water on medium-high in a medium saucepan. Add spinach and cook uncovered, stirring occasionally, until all the liquid has been absorbed and the spinach has wilted. Remove from the heat and cover, letting steam an additional 2 minutes. Add parmesan, lemon juice, olive oil, salt, and pepper, stirring well.

2. In a large bowl or storage container (2 cup capacity), assemble bowl with kale, chickpeas, garbanzo beans, cucumber, avocado, cherry tomatoes, olive oil, salt, and pepper. Stir well. Drizzle dressing with remaining olive oil, salt, and pepper. Toss well. Refrigerate until ready to eat.

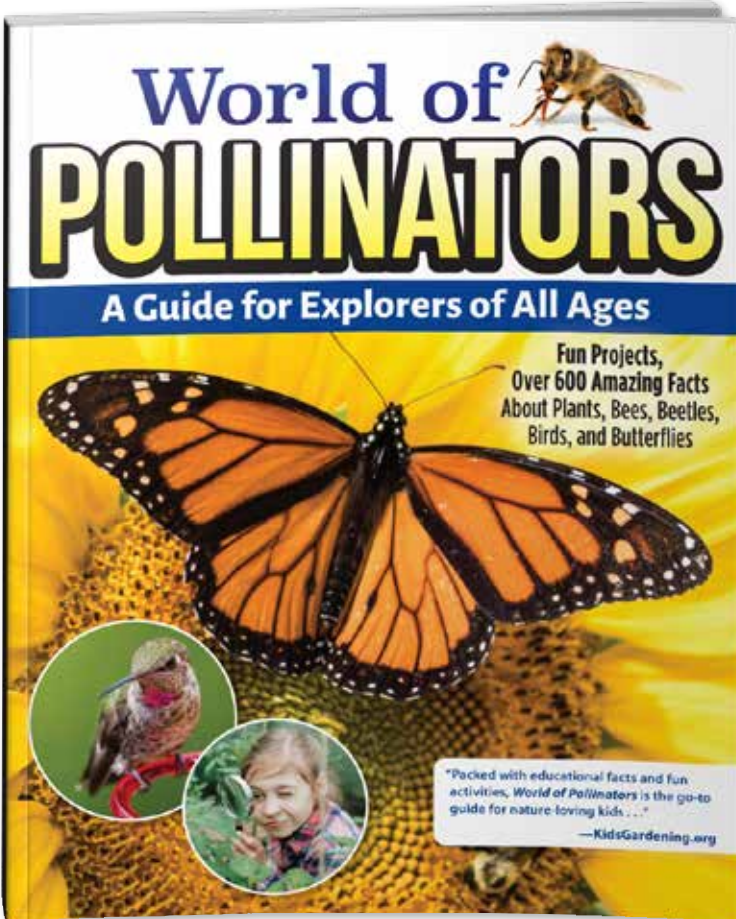

Where Pollination Happens In the Orchard

An orchard is a type of farm where fruits and nuts are grown on trees and shrubs. Examples of orchard fruits are apples, pears, oranges, bananas, and cherries. Examples of orchard nuts are pecans, walnuts, and almonds.

No Bees, No Apples
 Without bees, most apple trees would not produce any apples at all. The pollen from a tree's flowers will not pollinate other flowers on the same tree. Trees need bees to help carry pollen from another tree to produce their fruit.

Orchard growers are always watching the number of bees and other pollinators working in their orchards. They will go to great lengths to keep their bees safe and happy and will also work with professional bee handlers to bring in extra bees during the early parts of the year when pollination is very important to producing high-quality fruit later in the summer and early fall months.

How much pollen do bees spread?

A single colony of bees can successfully pollinate 1.2 acres of land filled with fruit trees and vegetable plants.

Did YOU KNOW?
 The wooden box made to house a colony of bees is called an apiary. Honeybees work in the field, bring back pollen to the apiary, and turn it into honey. A bee yard is the place where all the apiaries (which are full of bees and bee-keeping equipment) are kept. These are located near the orchard fields. The average size of a beehive can range from 25,000-40,000 bees.

Bats are wild about bananas!
 Bats are very important to the pollination process for wild bananas, which are not the same as bananas you see at your local grocery store. Wild bananas are typically smaller and have larger seeds but can be eaten. Bats and birds help pollinate wild bananas when gathering nectar from the banana blossoms and carrying and dropping seeds when they leave the banana plant.

Did YOU KNOW?

Grapesvines can self-pollinate and don't need the help of pollinators to produce grapes. But most grape vineyards are surrounded by cover crops, many of which require the help of pollinators to grow. Cover crops such as mustard plants and grain plants like barley are planted to help keep soil from washing away when it rains, and they help keep the soil full of nutrients.

How many orchards are there in the world?
 There are an estimated 2.2 million fruit tree orchards in the world, with a collective 37 billion fruit trees.

All About Hummingbirds

Hummingbirds are the most active and important pollinators in the bird world. They are only found in the western hemisphere, which consists of North and South America and the very western parts of Europe and Africa. Hummingbirds are extremely fast flyers, and they can fly backward and sideways, which allows them to move in and out of flower blossoms quickly.

How did the hummingbird get its name?
 The name "hummingbird" comes from the humming noise they make as they beat their wings.

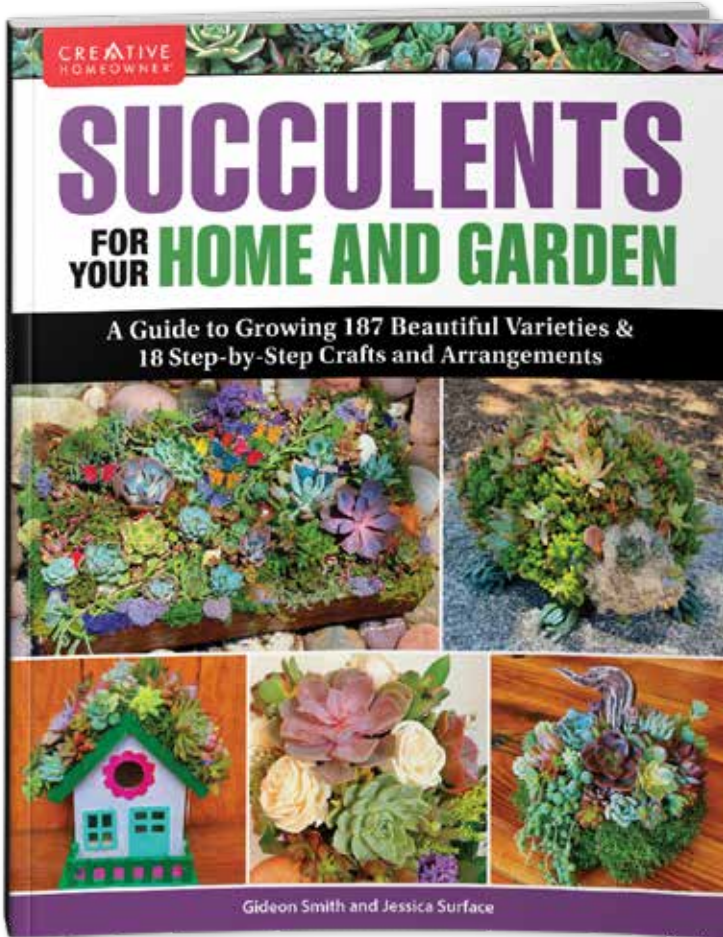
How fast is a hummingbird?
 Hummingbirds can fly up to 23 miles (37 km) an hour and up to 100 mph (161 kph). They can flap their wings from 10 to 80 times per second while hovering.

How long do hummingbirds live?
 Many hummingbirds can live up to 5 or even 10 years. A hummingbird's life span is greatly determined by the ability to find flowers producing nectar.

How do hummingbirds find nectar?
 Believe it or not, hummingbirds have no sense of smell. They find nectar by association, that is, bright colors mean sweet nectar is near!

 The legs of a hummingbird are its weakest part since most of their time is spent flying. They cannot walk or hop.
